Program Chairman Needed!

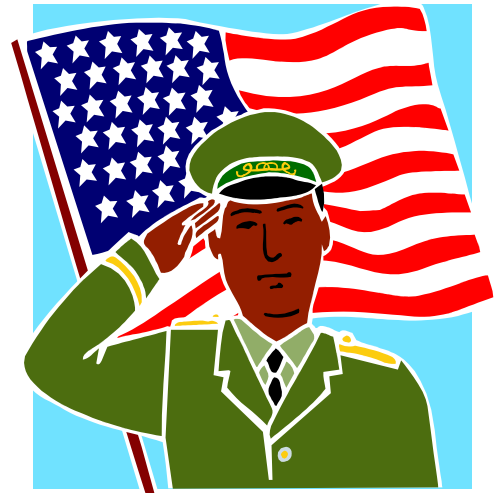
