On A Religious Note! *From the Desk of Deacon Jerry Butts.....*At the January council meeting I made a comment about how a persons Faith is in direct proportion to their prayer life and for evil to succeed in the world the only thing necessary is that good men do nothing. One way to keep our prayer life fresh is by changing a word so that it becomes a special prayer to you and takes it out of the routine in which you may have fallen. You could begin the Our Father by saying "My Father which are close hallowed be thy name" or the Hail Mary could end with "now, always, and at the hour of my death." You could make up a prayer to the Holy Spirit or just take some time to talk to God about what affects you today or what is going on in your life.
