## Definition of Fasting:

Fasting is the reduction of one's intake of food. The purpose of fasting is spiritual focus, imitation of Jesus, and penance. For members of the Roman Catholic Church, the norms for fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59 on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence from meat. (USCCB)
