The Jubilee Museum had a very rare and distinguished visitor last Tuesday; His Eminence Raymond Leo Cardinal Burke came for lunch and a tour. The Cardinal, despite the lofty title is a humble and prayerful servant of God and His people. He spent three hours with us after I picked him up at the Bishop's Office on East Broad Street and drove him to the museum. On the way I handed him a felt tip pen and asked him to autograph my dashboard. He asked me if I was serious. I told him that when he became Pope I would put my car in the museum. He laughed and signed his name and then remarked that he had never been asked to do that in his life.

The Cardinal spoke that evening at Meiling Hall in the College of Medicine at OSU. He and several other speakers, experts in law philosophy and medicine, made a clear case for life and a need for reform. The show will air on St. Gabriel radio. God reward all who put this program together.
