"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Fr. Burkley—May 17, 1880—May 18, 1972

This week is the anniversary of the birth and death of our beloved third pastor, Father Burkley. He was born in 1880 on S. Front Street, "within sight of the old Courthouse" as he used to say. He was baptized at St. Mary's, studied for the priesthood at the Pontifical College Josephinum and was ordained a priest by Bishop Hartley in 1905. Father Burkley was appointed assistant pastor in 1906 for only, as Bishop Hartley put it, "a short time." He remained at St. Mary's until his retirement 64 years later. He was named Domestic Prelate in 1934 by Pope Pius XI and named Protonotary Apostolic by Pope Paul VI in 1965, the second priest to be named to this high honor in the diocese. Father Burkley retired in 1969. Father Burkley once admonished a reporter, "Don't raise me to the skies, because the fall's too far. Reserve the nice things for my funeral, when I don't have to blush." Requiescat In Pace.
