From the old oak tree

Trees do not need to brag! But every now and then we like to point out some interesting little tree fact. Together we have a huge collective memory, and so it's nice to share things of a common interest with you all.

It was one of my cousins, a tree growing on the farm of Jacob Dittoe. Jacob had written to Bishop John Carroll and asked him to send a priest for the scattered Catholics. Soon enough, Father Fenwick showed up riding on a horse; and he soon offered Mass under the spreading branches of the luckiest tree on the Dittoe farm. Even those early Catholic settlers knew what an important moment this was, and they cut branches after Mass from the tree and kept them as souvenirs. If you would like to see a branch from my cousin, stop at the Jubilee Museum. It's in the case right next to the deed for the Dittoe Farm; and the deed was signed in 1808 by President Thomas Jefferson and recorded by James Madison, Secretary of State.
