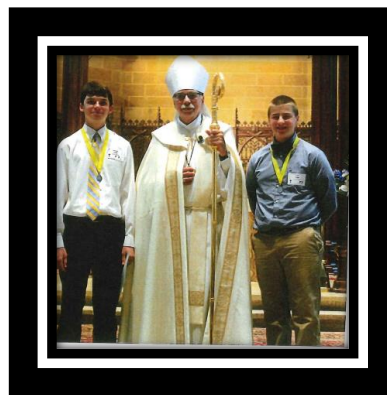
"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Remembering Our Daughters
