*“Grand Old Saint Mary”* Deja Vou – 1930’s  
As we sit here in the wilderness (gym), does this description of Saint Mary Church from the 1930’s renovation bring back memories?

1. The stairways to the choir were moved from the vestibule to the north and south sides of the church.
2. The old confessionals were removed and replaced with new ones, two on each side of the church. Brick bump outs were constructed to accommodate them. Unfortunately, the church wall was not properly reinforced so the bump outs must now go.
3. The Baptismal font was moved from in front by Blessed Virgin’s Altar to the rear of the church to the alcove on the north side of the entrance where a confessional is today.
4. The Pieta was moved to the alcove on the south side of the church entrance.
5. Three dimensional Stations of the Cross were installed along the north and south walls.
6. A new carved wood Communion railing was installed and the huge Crucifix was hung on chains in the Sanctuary.
