"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Father Dury

Father Dury, assistant pastor at St. Mary in 1934, followed the tradition established by Father Burkley, of serving the needs of the deaf community. Father Burkley had established this tradition at the Ohio School for the Deaf prior to his ordination in 1905 until 1925. When he was appointed pastor of St. Mary, he was tasked with training his replacement from his assistants at St. Mary. Father Dury served as chaplain at the Ohio School for the Deaf during his 11 years as assistant at St. Mary to 1945. Father Dury said Mass every Sunday for approximately 40 Catholic children out of a total enrollment of 360. Every week he instructed the children using sign language. Father Dury pointed out that it was edifying to see the sincere devotion on the part of the afflicted young people in their attention to Mass and the sacraments. In 1940, he performed a sign language marriage for Miss Kay Konkler, a graduate of the Ohio School for the Deaf and Jerome Welker, a graduate of St. Rita's School for the Deaf. In 1952, Father Burkley was asked to train his assistants Father Schroeder and Father Patterson as Father Dury's replacements.
