"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Vocations-Parish Schools
The connection between vocations and a Catholic education at a parish school is sometimes difficult to make in this day of overwhelming social media and electronic gaming. The secular influence of these distractions makes it extremely difficult for religious ideas and ideals to penetrate young minds. The parish Catholic school provides an opportunity for young people to put aside outside distractions and observe our religion in action through the close interaction with clergy and like-minded teachers on a daily basis. An example from the "Good Old Days" illustrates the influence of St. Mary High School and the parish environment. In the August 16, 1946 diocesan newspaper, The Columbus Recorder, was the story of five Columbus girls who took part in the reception and profession ceremonies of the Order of St. Francis' convent, Joliet, Illinois. Four of them received the white veil of novices, Mary Louise Duffy, Dorothy Schlueb, Adrian Golson and Elaine Schneider. They were all graduates of St. Mary High School. As were Sister Jean Marie Duffy and Sister Mary Karen, who took the black veil and made their first profession of vows. The parents and St. Mary pastor, Monsignor Burkley were present for the ceremonies.
