"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Renovation-Footsteps

In last Sunday's bulletin Father Lutz suggested that if we listened very closely this week we could hear the first footsteps of renovation in our darkened church. Remember? In 1965, one of our dear teachers, Sister Miriam Joseph (Hilda) Eckelkamp, who taught here from 1948 to 1958, described her experience in our church. "I remember, with reverence and awe, the atmosphere of prayerfulness one experienced immediately on entering St. Mary's old fashioned Church. That awe extended to the pastor, Monsignor (Father) Burkley and his assistants. When any service was in progress, pastor and assistants knelt in the sanctuary. This participation of priests and faithful gave realness to Christ's promise, 'where two or three are gathered together, there am I in the midst of them.' Services, whether High Mass or devotions were solemn and festive because the choir also helped make it so. Many is the time I long to hear again the mellow, well-harmonized voices." What do you remember? Sister Miriam Joseph passed away December 31, 2006, after serving for 72 years as a member of the Joliet Franciscans. God bless all the Religious who labor long and faithfully in our Church.
