"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Hall of Fame

Fran Ryan: In 1973 the Catholic Men's Luncheon Club speaker was a recently elected, 1971, City Councilwoman, graduate of "Old" St. Mary's High School, class of 1952, Francine Lottridge (Fran) Ryan. The topic of her talk was "The Future of the City of Columbus." It seems that Fran has spent her life helping others. Fran was born in New York and came to Columbus for her junior and senior years at St. Mary's High School where she was Secretary of her graduating class. Fran graduated from the Ohio State University School of Journalism and worked as a reporter for the old Columbus Citizen newspaper. She did public relations work for the Chamber of Commerce, Catholic Charities, The March of Dimes, Ohio Dominican College, the Arthritis Foundation and the Columbus Symphony. She was a board member for the North YMCA, Sixpence school, and the Epilepsy Foundation. Fran served as City Clerk, Franklin County Commissioner, Chairwoman of the County Board of Elections, senior services liaison with the Office of the Mayor. Her volunteer efforts did not stop after her retirement as Chairwoman of the Franklin County Democratic Party. She has received the YWCA's Woman of Achievement Award and was named as one of Columbus's "Outstanding Women You Should Know" and received the 2015 Carrie Nelson Black Award. Fran was Chairwoman of the 1994 St. Mary's "Save the Steeple" campaign with Father Huntzinger, and is a tireless worker on the current "Save St. Mary Church" campaign. Fran, and the others like her, are the example of what makes "Grand Old St. Mary's" grand.
