"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Sister Joan Preising O. S. F. 1926-1935 For over 100 years the Sisters of Saint Francis of Mary Immaculate, Joliet, Illinois have faithfully served this parish and its schools. One of those individuals was Sister Joan Preising who served as the science teacher at Old St. Mary's High School from 1926 until 1935. The following article appeared in the October 1935 edition of the school newspaper. "With the reopening of school the students of St. Mary failed to find the smiling face of Sister Joan. The students all regretted her leaving for she was an excellent teacher and a splendid friend. (Emphasis added). Sister Joan is now pursuing her studies in Chemistry at the Illinois University, Urbana, Where she hopes to receive her doctorate in science. Happiness and continued success in her new field of labor are the wishes of the students of St. Mary." She must have been a special person to have evoked such positive comments from her students. The feelings must have been mutual, for she included several references to St. Mary (under the pseudonym, St. Albert) in her book, "All the Days of My Life." In the December 1959 issue of *The Catholic Times* she is shown autographing copies of her book for former students, Tony Thomas, Class of '35, Mrs. Betty Wenger, Class of '35, and Mrs. Albert Wolf, Class of '33. If anyone has a copy of Sister Joan's book and would like to contribute it to St. Mary museum it would be greatly appreciated.
