"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Father Lappan-Beloved Confessor
Father Joseph W. Lappan had been assistant pastor at Saint Mary's for twenty-four years, from 1922 to 1946, the longest tenure of any assistant. Father Lappan was born in 1883 in O'Neil, Nebraska, ordained June 1, 1912, in Philadelphia and was assigned to Saint Mary's from Bellville, Illinois in 1922. During his long years of service to the parish, he was quite active with the Holy Name Society and was considered the founder of the athletic program at the high school. Father Lappan frequently spent his own money to equip and transport the various sports teams, and often functioned as coach, trainer and athletic director. Father Lappan was well known in the diocese. People from all over Columbus and as far away as Chillicothe would come to him for Confession. For many years, Father Lappan would hear Confessions at St. Mary Magdalene church during the perpetual novena services in honor of the Miraculous medal. He was deeply devoted to the Blessed Virgin and the Miraculous medal. Father Lappan was appointed administrator of St. Mary's parish, Bremen in January 1946 where he passed away August 11, 1949. Bishop Ready was the celebrant of the Pontifical Requiem Mass at St. Mary's church with Father Burkley assisting. Requiescat in Pace.
