GRANT TO US, O LORD

We are very grateful to have received grants from The Catholic Foundation this year for the following purposes:

- A grant of \$7000 was received for St. Mary's St. Vincent de Paul Society to help with utilities, rent and other needs for those who are struggling financially.
We applied and received a grant in the amount of \$10,000 for the Dominican Sisters to help them renovate part of their convent as a vocation center for young women interested in learning more about religious life. Dominican Sister Vianneya is currently working at St. Mary School and Sisters Leonarda and Paulina worked in St. Mary Parish and School last year.
We have also received a grant in the amount of \$2800 for our senior citizen "Spiritual and Social Journeys. Our next trip to Niagara Falls is set for this June.

"Grand Old Saint Mary's" Father Anthony J. Domm Father Anthony J. Domm, was assistant pastor to Saint Mary's from his ordination in 1904 until his appointment as Pastor of Dresden, Saint Ann from 1913 to 1926, and Pastor of Coshocton, Sacred Heart until his death in 1946. Father Domm was born in Cologne, Germany, December 19, 1877. After completing theology training at Mt. St. Mary's, Cincinnati, Father Domm, along with Rev. Dennis J. Dunne were the first priests to be ordained by Bishop James J. Hartley. Father Domm was then assigned to St. Mary's and he offered his first Solemn Mass in Saint Mary's church. The pastor at the time was our first pastor, Father Specht. Father Domm left St. Mary's in 1913, the year Father Specht passed away and Father Wehrle was assigned to replace him as pastor. During his time at St. Mary's he served as assistant alongside Fathers Burkley and von Lintel. Bishop Michael J. Ready was the celebrant of a Solemn Pontifical Funeral Mass in Coshocton Sacred Heart church, June 21, 1946. The Rt. Rev. Monsignor Edmund A. Burkley, pastor of Columbus, St. Mary's, delivered the sermon. Requiescat in Pace.
