So glad that Phase II of the church repair is finished. The final Phase *here beginneth*. The big projects will include: wiring, sound system, plaster repair to walls, new plaster ceiling, tile floor entries, staircase to basement for maintenance, restroom in north sacristy, leveling of floors of second floor (the storage areas, hall, and hand bell choir room), HVAC, cleaning of reredos (the grand wood carving that stands in the main arch), cleaning and tuning of the pipe organ, installation of two confessionals, church floor restoration, and return of the restored statues. What did I miss?...probably lots. Getting exciting!

Hard hat tours have gone very well. So much to see; so much to do, but the finish line is in sight. Stop by after any weekend Mass and take a tour that lasts about 20 minutes. Feel free to take pictures and promote the good cause.

*Grand Old Saint Mary's* Sister M. Rose Agnes Zollner

BORN: September 17, 1904 FIRST PROFESSION: August 12, 1927  
DIED: September 18, 1988

The importance of a parish based Catholic education to vocations is again apparent in the story of Sister Mary Rose Agnes. Sister was born in Austria in 1904 to John and Karoline (Schumich) Zollner. The family immigrated into the United States in 1908. They settled in Columbus where she attended Saint Mary Grade and High Schools, graduating in 1925. Later in life, she wrote of the people who most influenced her life at Saint Mary. She praised Sr. Julia who taught her the English language, Sr. Eulogia who challenged her to be a scholar and leader, and the pastor, Father Wehrle, who instilled in her a love for the Church. Almost her entire career was consumed with teaching. Sr. Rose Agnes received degrees from DePaul, Catholic University, Notre Dame, and studied at John Carroll and St. Louis Universities. Starting in 1926-1932 at St. Clements in Chicago, she taught freshmen and sophomores, 1932-1938, St. Francis Academy, Joliet, English, Spanish, Shorthand, and Latin, 1938-1942, Toledo Central Catholic, Religion, Spanish, and History, 1942-1944, Catholic University of America, Graduate Studies, 1944-1970, College of St. Francis in Joliet, Department of Philosophy and Religion, 1970-1981, Religious Education Office, Diocese of Joliet. Her sisters survived Sr. Rose Agnes: Frances Haban, Caroline Niklas, Agnes Parsons and brothers: Richard and John Zollner. Unfortunately, she never returned to teach at "Grand Old St. Mary's". She celebrated her sixtieth anniversary as a nun the year before she passed away. Requiescat in Pace.
