- We hope we can continue to grow our list of adorers. Come September, hopefully, our list of those coming to Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will grow. (It is necessary that there is someone in the chapel at all times when there is exposition of the Blessed Sacrament in the monstrance.)
- Those who have given of their time in prayer each week will tell you it is something very special in their life.
