Father Valentine has been visiting with us for the past few weeks. It has been a pleasure to have his company and his very generous spirit of helping with Masses. The Jubilee Museum is giving him a very large container of Altars, Tabernacles, desks, books and vestments. It's going to cost about \$4,500 to send shipping containers to Nigeria and another \$2-\$3,000 to have these things crated using specially treated wood to send to Africa (necessary for the safe transportation of large items). If you would like to help, please talk to me. This is truly a mission effort for the Church in Africa.



Say "Hello" to **Kevin the Dog**. As I was taking my little walk through the parish and praying for people, I came across a dog named Kevin. The original St. Kevin, according to Irish legend, was pursued up a hill by his sweet colleen to a monastery he wanted to enter. Supposedly they struggled along the path and he gave her a rather unsaintly shove into the lake below. (There is an old Irish tune: "By That Lake whose Gloomy Shore" in commemoration of this.)
