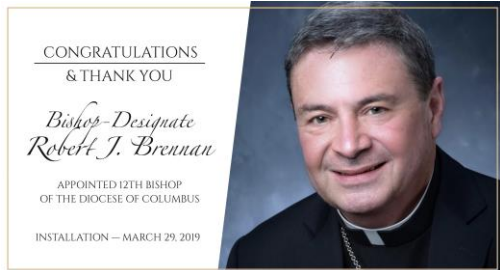

"Grand Old Saint Mary's" - "Gala"

The first Gala was held in 2006 but it was not the first tuition assistance fundraiser to begin in 2006, and continue to today. In September 2006, the members of the 4-S Club began a reverse raffle, horseracing and a golf outing to raise funds for St. Mary Catholic School tuition assistance fund. The 4-S Club is a union of Catholic organizations. It was originally composed of four Catholic societies: Saint Francis Xavier Society, Saint Paul Society, Catholic Order of Foresters, and the Knights of Saint John. In 2004, the Knights of Columbus were added but the name remained the *4-S Club*. One of the organizers, Eileen Hoffman, explained in a *This Week in German Village* article by Sue Hagan "Tuition continues to rise at St. Mary...Parents are having a harder time meeting the tuition amount." The horse race consisted of a series of races in which club members raced on hobbyhorses with each move based on rolls of the dice. Participants bet on each race. The Current Gala is called "A Night at the Races". Will we have a hobbyhorse race? I would pay to see Father Lutz on a hobbyhorse. The National Order of Foresters matched \$1,500 of the proceeds raised. The golf outing took place at Foxfire Golf Club. Both affairs netted \$18,000 for St. Mary School Tuition Assistance fund. Sister Regina Snyder, St. Mary principal, commented in the *German Village Gazette* article by Garth Bishop declared, "It was wonderful." Bob Dolder, president and founder of the 4-S Club Golf Association; made the presentation accompanied by Sharon Wentzel, treasurer; Pat McCaren: Cindy Bellerose; and Ray Brahler. In 2014, the event was named the "Robert Dolder, Sr. & Sharon Wentzel Memorial Golf Classic.
